

CONSERVATION POLICY

All of our remote lakes are managed with the catch and release method of large breeding fish. Limits of fish may not be filleted and taken home. Guests may shore lunch smaller fish for meals in camp. This has proven to be a positive approach to the remote fly-in fishing experience and gives you, our guest, the best opportunity to catch a lot of fish including "the Big One". Bring the camera and show your friends the one that got away! By helping to conserve our resources for the future, we can guarantee you an unforgettable Canadian fly-in fishing adventure.

WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING

Warm clothing, good raingear, sleeping bag, fishing gear, food, beverages, camera, film, insect repellent and personal items. Kenora offers three grocery stores for your convenience. Also, licenses, bait and tackle may be purchased locally before your flight.

HOW TO REACH US

Nothing beats a summer getaway at one of our remote camps. Problem is, some of you spend the better part of two days or more on the road just getting here and back again. Problem solved. For guests wishing to save travel time, you can fly directly into Winnipeg, Manitoba or International Falls, Minnesota airports. From there we are only a two and a half hour drive. Many guests either rent a car or take Sunset Limousine Van service (807) 548-1450, from either airport. Prelude Travel can make all reservations for you from flights, to car rental, to hotel arrangements. Call them toll free at 1-800-561-8907 for a "Fisherman's Fare". For those driving, clear customs in Fort Frances/International Falls, take Hwy 11 to Hwy 71, North 130 miles to Highway 17. Left on 17 (11 miles) to Kenora. Once you have arrived in Kenora proceed to the seaplane base, 2nd Street dock on the Harbourfront.

Brown Bear Lake

**SMALLMOUTH BASS, WALLEYE,
NORTHERN PIKE & LAKE TROUT**

Moose Point Lodge - only cabin on lake

The Brown Bear Lake system is considered to be one of the best fly-in trophy Smallmouth Bass lakes in the area. The Smallmouth in this lake average 2-3 pounds. Four pound fish are common, and trophy wall-hangers (5-6 pounds) are produced every season. Also Brown Bear Lake offers fast-action Northern Pike and some lunker Walleyes.

Now you'd think that would be enough to keep you busy, but we've got more. Portages! Three of them!



The first is a four minute walk from Brown Bear Lake to the backwaters of Midway Lake where three boats and motors are waiting for you. You carry only your fishing rod, and maybe your lunch for the day. By boat, you can travel from Midway Lake West to Midway Lake East, through a scenic remote waterway, about 5 miles long. Both of these portage lakes are full of Smallies and fast-action Pike. Many of our guests have reported Moose sightings in this area.

Now if you're not too tired, we have another portage (4 minute walk) from Midway Lake to Beauty Lake. Beauty Lake is our fighting Lake Trout destination, along with some more of the nicest Smallmouth fishing that you will ever see. From here we have one more portage for that devoted Walleye fisherman. The trail is located at the northwest end of Beauty Lake and it is not for the weak-hearted. A 20 Minute walk up and down rugged, wooded terrain brings you to a pretty little lake called Robin Lake. Here you will find numerous Walleye and Northern Pike that don't see a fisherman's lure all that often.

Moose Point Lodge is a deluxe 3-bedroom cottage and has over one thousand feet of living space, capable of comfortably accommodating large groups up to twelve. The camp is located high on a point, on a quiet bay in the heart of Brown Bear Lake. It is private and remote, and has complete kitchen facilities, hot and cold running water, hot showers and a screened-in porch with large wraparound deck overlooking the lake. Remember, we are the only outfitter on Brown Bear Lake. That means that we can give you the entire lake all to yourselves.

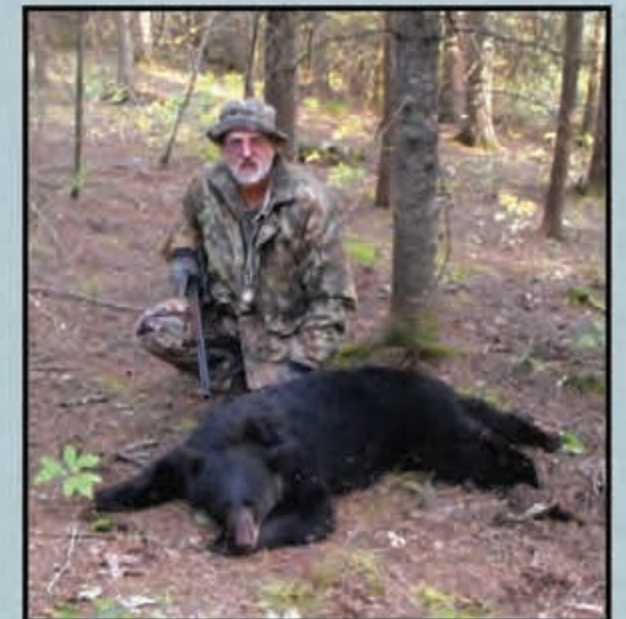
We offer a fully guided Black Bear Hunt. Our bear hunting area is large, exclusive to our guests, either drive-in or fly-in, and is known for its high quality bear habitat. It has the highest density of Black Bears in the area with some color phased bears. This area has lots of streams, small lakes, plenty of brush for cover and abundant food sources for bears. There are old logged areas that have grown up with cover and provide great berry habitat including blueberries, raspberries, strawberries and cherries. We have plenty of active sites that we pre-bait long before our first hunters show up. With our area being quite large and diverse in terrain, we take a variety of vehicles to get you into the bear hunting sites. We use all of our own equipment, ATV, Truck or Boat to take you to the bear hunt sites.

We have scouted different sites in our Bear Management Area and set up our bait sites that will attract the largest majority of bears. With an exclusive bear hunting area, we can guarantee a high success rate as we determine the amount of hunters we put through our area during the hunting season.

Our professional guides take you to the stands for your watch and then pick you up afterwards. We have a variety of permanent, portable and two person stands to hunt from. If you or someone in your group is of larger status please let us know in advance so we can make other arrangements for stand positioning or type of stand. We offer field dressing, trophy care and freezer service as part of the bear hunting package. Our guides have been in the business for a long time and are professional and courteous.

Most bear hunters start their day out fishing in the mornings, come in for lunch, relax a little before they go out in the afternoons to their stand.

Our Bear Hunting package includes deluxe accommodations at our main camp or fly-in outpost, trophy care, freezer service, use of our boats and motors with gas. Not included in the price is tax, Hunting & Fishing Licence and Export Permit.

Populus Lake

WALLEYE, NORTHERN PIKE, LAKE TROUT



Populus Lake Outpost provides the opportunity for the avid or beginner fisherman to enjoy a true Canadian fly-in fishing experience. It also offers the adventurous the opportunity to see abundant wildlife such as bear, moose, bald eagles or deer.

The outpost is a fully modern cabin with complete kitchen facilities, hot and cold running water, full bathroom including shower and flush toilet. The living area has cathedral ceiling with skylights and a cozy wood burning stove for those cool evenings. This camp offer luxuries not normally found in a fly-in camp. The cabin is ideal for smaller groups or couples up to four people.

Boats and motors at this lake are 14' boats with new Yamaha motors, all in excellent condition. We have life jackets, raised swivel seats, landing nets and bait buckets for your use.

Gold Mine Lodge - Betula, John Lake
Great for small groups and couples

Populus Lake offers over twelve miles of water to fish and explore. The lake system consists of numerous channels and bays with structure consisting of rock outcrops, points and weed beds (with the deepest part of the lake being over 150 feet). The lake is surrounded by high picturesque terrain that allows anglers to fish even on the windiest days. This lake is situated in a very remote area set aside from all logging activity. It is a true Canadian Wilderness vacation.

Great fishing experiences on Populus Lake begin right from the cabin. You can fish the weed beds and points for Walleye and Northern Pike or troll and jig the depths for Lake Trout. The north end of the lake also offers the angler the opportunity to hook onto a Muskie. Walleyes run from two to six pounds with trophies caught every season. Catches of Lake Trout in May and June are common, with fish averaging five to ten pounds, and trophies as large as twenty-five pounds. Northern Pike are eagerly waiting in the weeds or off the rock points for your jigs, spoons or crank baits. Northern pike have been caught as large as twenty-five pounds in this water system with the average being five to ten pounds.

This flowage system also offers two portage lakes without having to walk or get out of your boat. Betula Lake offers the angler opportunities to catch more Walleye, Northern Pike and Trout. The lake offers similar structure with over five miles of water to fish. John Lake is a small lake located down a scenic river system. This lake is dark water and is teeming with Walleye and Northern Pike.

Unexpected Lake

WALLEYE, NORTHERN PIKE,

English River Outpost - only cabin on the Lake

Our newest acquired outpost on Unexpected Lake is located on the English River system in the Oak Lake West Provincial Park. It is world renowned for it's awesome Walleye, Northern Pike, Muskellunge and Smallmouth Bass fishing.

This is a Walleye anglers dream! This outpost truly has it all!

Muskies are caught and released each season in the 40" to 50" range. Walleyes are abundant and there have been trophy sized fish caught and released to be enjoyed by future anglers. Smallmouth Bass are plentiful and what can we say about the big Northern Pike, except monsters!

Unexpected Lake is a flowage system with two rivers entering the lake from the north and northwest, flowing past the cabin into Wilcox Lake and into the English River, where it flows south over two falls and dumps into Oak Lake. The lake is dark colored water with current breaks and rock hump structure teeming with Walleyes for fast action, even into the hot summer months.



Our rustic outpost cabin will accommodate groups from four up to eight people comfortably. The cabin has a large screened in porch, screened in fish cleaning house and kitchen/dining area. Cabin has tongue and groove pine interior, two sets of comfortable twin bunk beds in the two bedrooms, hot and cold running water with a shower, electric fridge and upright chest freezer, propane stove, electric lights, all run by a 24 hour generator service. We also have propane lighting for the guests that want to enjoy the quiet evening sunsets.

Boats and motors at this outpost are brand new and are 14' and 16' with new 9.9 and 8hp Yamaha motors for trouble free use. We have life jackets, raised swivel seats, landing nets and bait buckets for your use as well. This cabin is a four person minimum for the season.

Wolves' Den - Only Cabin on Lake

Norse Lake is a prime example of a remote Canadian wilderness lake. The lake is protected by a high picturesque landscape. On the days when high winds would blow your boat off the average lake, Norse stays pretty calm. Fishing consists of Walleye, Northern Pike and Smallmouth Bass. Walleye average 1-3 pounds with the 4-10 pound trophies caught every season. The lake also sports a healthy population of Northern Pike with trophies reaching up to and over 40 inches every season. There is also a good Smallmouth Bass population reaching up to the 5 pound class.

In addition to Norse Lake we also have a portage trail along an unspoiled wilderness rapids leading to Little Norse Lake. Little Norse offers more Walleye, Smallmouth and Northern Pike. All you carry is your fishing pole, as we already have the boat and motor waiting for you.

The Wolves' Den is a 2 bedroom, deluxe cottage located on the west end of Norse Lake. This cabin can comfortably accommodate your group. It has complete kitchen facilities with hot and cold running water, hot showers, a cathedral ceiling with skylights in the living area and a large screened in porch, which leads to a wraparound deck with a view overlooking the lake for two miles. Boats and motors are 16-foot Lunds with swivel seats powered by new Yamaha motors.

SMALLMOUTH BASS, NORTHERN PIKE

Black Wolf Lodge - On a point with a sheltered Bay - Only cabin on the lake

Picture in your mind a cool, gin clear Canadian lake with lots of fighting trophy Smallmouth Bass and Northern Pike and you've got Treelined Lake. The Smallmouth in this lake are averaging 17-18 inches (2-3 pounds) on every catch with 4-5 pound fish (20-22 inches) taken regularly. The Northern Pike are averaging 5-7 pounds with 15-20 pound lunkers taken every season. This lake is remarkably clear in that you'll be able to sight fish the Smallmouth Bass close to the shoreline. A camera is a must for this outpost as you will witness follow-ups to the boat with 2-3 Bass at any one time. Wildlife is also abundant in this area. It is very possible to see Moose feeding along the shoreline during twilight hours and nesting Eagles right across the bay from your cabin. And, of course, you can always expect to hear the call of the Canadian Loon to break the silence of the evening. This is a beautiful, unspoiled adventure that only a Canadian fly-in fishing trip can offer.

Black Wolf Lodge is a deluxe two bedroom cabin with cathedral ceiling, skylights, large screened-in porch with wrap-around deck, complete kitchen facilities, hot and cold running water and hot showers. This cabin, along with our others, is one of the finest in the area. Boats and motors are 16-foot Lunds with swivel seats, powered by Yamaha motors. Give us a call for all the details.



Gordie Lake

NORTHERN PIKE, WALLEYE

Chalet Outpost - only cabin on the lake

Our newest built fly-in outpost lodge is located on Gordie Lake, part of the Campfire River system. It is a fast action Northern Pike and Walleye lake with dark water, lots of structure to fish, a waterfall, rocks and weed beds. It is a flowage system.

The lake is in two parts. The upper portion of the lake is 2-1/2 miles long where the cabin is and has the river dumping into it over a small set of rapids. Across from the cabin is the outflow river that you boat down and go into the second part of the lake, which is a big heart shaped body of water with rock and weed beds that is about 2 miles across. The river continues south from this part of the lake. We are the only outfitter on this system and it is the only cabin on the lake. The average Walleye is 1 to 2 lbs. with larger ones caught in the 5 lb. range and abundant Northern Pike are 24 to 30 inch average with 40 inch fish caught. The lake had not been used as an outpost in over 15 years. We have fished it on occasion as a boat cache lake before the outpost was built. It is one of our better Pike lakes because of the Campfire River System that runs through it.

The lodge is a five star cabin with two bedrooms that sleeps up to six. The living room/dining room is open concept with a woodstove and futon in the living area. Large bright kitchen has propane stove, electric refrigerator, hot and cold running water and solar lights. All cooking utensils are provided. There is a bathroom with shower and sink. There is a backup generator for lights but mostly it runs on solar power. There is also a large screened in porch out front facing the lake as well as a deck to spend some time relaxing when not on the lake. We have a propane barbeque on the deck and propane fish cooker located outside off the deck for you to use. There is a fish cleaning table by the lake. Boats are 14' Lunds with new Yamaha motors.
